At NMBU, various social media platforms are used to convey information about student life in general. You can find a lot of information on NMBU's websites. In addition, the buddy week has its official account (fadderukanmbu) where they share more information about the program for the entire university. Therefore, it may be beneficial to have a profile on Instagram and/or Facebook, or to be in good contact with others who do. Additionally, Facebook/Messenger is often used to keep in touch with fellow students, such as other buddy kids and your buddies, and for things like class chats or social unions.

Buddy week 2024

Buddy week serves as an introduction to student life. The goal for the buddy week is to provide you with information about the university and student life, facilitate getting to know many new people, and give you the best possible welcome! During buddy week, you will be introduced to your classmates, other students who can share their experiences, NMBU's beautiful campus, Ås town center, unions and organizations, the Studentsamfunnet, and much more!

The buddy week for the entire university starts on Friday, August 9, and lasts until Sunday, August 25. Here at NMBU, we have chosen to have a longer buddy week for the students to have the opportunity to get to know each other well and do a lot of fun activities. At the same time, we spread it out a bit and allow for rest days. During buddy week, you will meet other buddy kids, buddies (volunteer students), buddy leaders (leaders for the buddy week at their faculty), and the buddy board led by the buddy general. Additionally, you will be introduced to various bodies and unions affiliated with NMBU and the Studentsamfunnet.

Buddy week is filled with many different activities and events. Some activities are only for students at BIOVIT, while other events are for several faculties or the entire university! We have tried to put together a buddy week where everyone can enjoy something they like, and where everyone's needs are met. This means there will be everything from relaxed events with some food and a pleasant atmosphere to events filled with activities and tasks to solve, as well as larger pre-parties and themed parties!

What happens next?

As a new student at NMBU, you will automatically become a buddy kid. You will be contacted by your buddy via email and/or phone. If you have not been contacted by a buddy by August 9, send an email to fadderuka.biovit@nmbu.no or contact one of us buddy leaders (contact information is at the bottom of the document). You will share your buddy with several other students, and you and your buddy will belong to a buddy group. All buddy groups will have a shared chat where information will be provided and where you can ask questions about the buddy week or student life in general.

Orientation week begins on Friday, August 9, at 3:00 PM at the BIOVIT tent (NIBIO-lawn). After that, we will walk together to Auditorium Maximum (Aud.Max.) where we will meet at 5:00 PM. There you will receive practical information from the buddy general, and the program will last a maximum of 2 hours (including breaks). After you are finished, you will meet your buddies again, and there will be pizza and fun throughout the evening at the BIOVIT tent.
