

How to submit your doctoral thesis:

Go to <https://nmbu.brage.unit.no/nmbu-xmlui/handle/11250/92927> and log in using your NMBU username and password (FEIDE).

Choose your [Sub-Archive](#) (= your faculty)

Choose collection [Doctoral theses](#)

Click on [Submit a new item to this collection](#)

NB! All fields NOT mentioned in this guide should be left empty!

Describe Item (1):

Authors: your name

Advisor: your supervisors name, if more than one: click the ADD-button between names

Title: enter the title of your thesis. If you have a translated title: use **Other Titles**

Subtitle is part of Main title, separate with :

Date of Issue: enter Year (mandatory. Skip Month and Day)

Publisher: Norwegian University of Life Sciences, Ås

Series Name: PhD Thesis

Report or paper No.: your Thesis number, format: 201x:xx

Project: use if relevant

Identifiers: enter ISSN and ISBN separated with the ADD-button

Type: choose Doctoral thesis

Language: choose the main language used in your thesis

Describe Item (2):

Keywords: enter your own keywords separated with the ADD-button

Abstract: copy/paste the abstract from your thesis. If multiple languages: separates with the ADD-button. This field may be edited with lineshift (Enter)

Sponsors: use only if relevant

Geographical area: use only if relevant (geographical area as subject for your thesis, not your location)

Access Settings:

If your thesis can't be published in Brage immediately after the defense (embargo), you must enter the date for its publication here.

Click [NEXT](#)

Upload File(s):

Choose file: Your thesis should be uploaded as one file as printed, errata may be uploaded separately. Do **not** register embargo on the file(s) as the embargo set on the previous page is enough.
