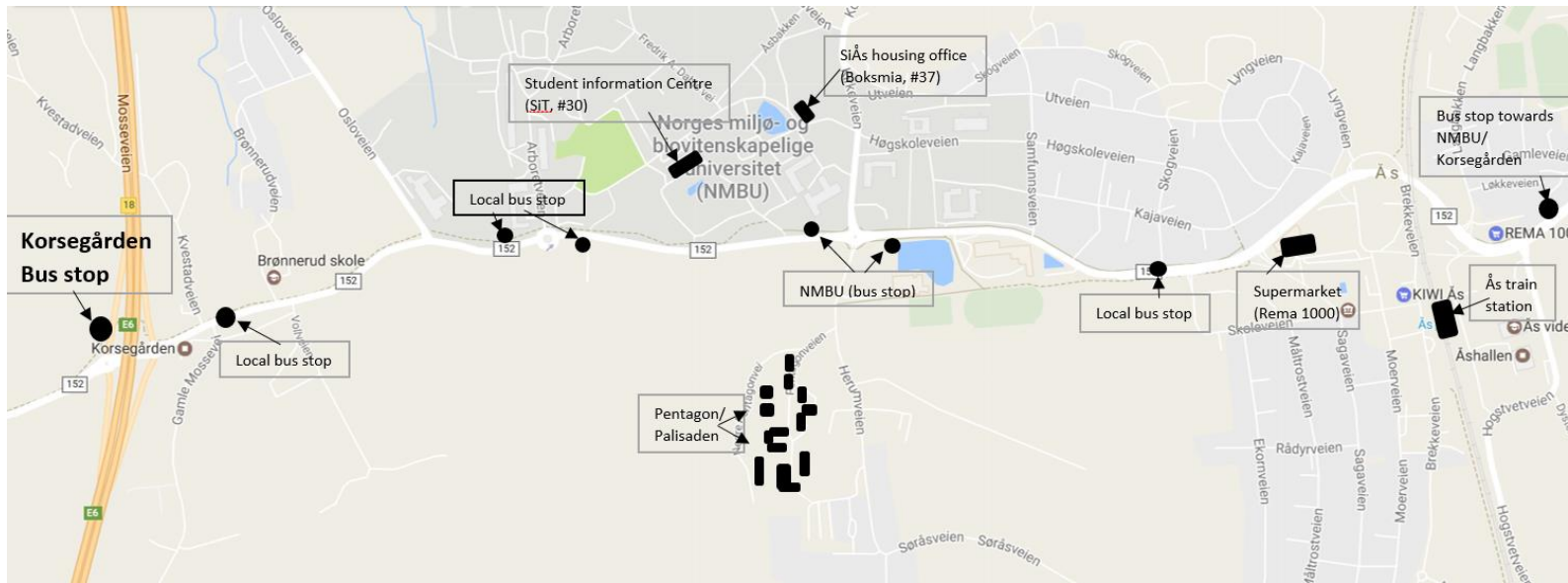


How to travel to Grålum

Please note that the immigration Office in Grålum is only open Monday and Wednesday between 09:00-15:00.

From Ås, you take the local bus or walk to Korsegården. See map above, Korsegården is to the left on the map. At the petrol station at Korsegården you cross the bridge over to Korsegården bus stop.

From Korsegården you take bus number **TE3** towards “**Sarpsborg**”. The bus runs every hour starting at 33 minutes past the hour. However, we recommend checking the updated bus schedule from the link provided above. If you buy a ticket on the bus, the price is 190 NOK for adult and 140 NOK for student. However, the ticket can be much cheaper if you buy it online before your departure, follow the link above (NB! Ticket sales online closes 1 hour before departure).

Tell the bus driver you want to get off at “**Lekevollkrysset E6**”. It takes about 50 minutes and Lekevollkrysset is the 7th stop after Korsegården.

When you arrive in Grålum, follow the map below of Grålum to the immigration office. The walk takes 5 minutes.

Most Norwegians are comfortable speaking English, so just ask for directions if you get lost.

When you wish to return to Ås, follow the map to the bus stop called “Quality Hotel”. Take bus TE3 towards Oslo, get off at Korsegården. The bus departs every hour, 17 minutes past the hour. Check updated timetable from the link above.
