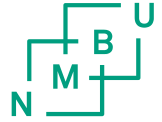

# Two new applications with EU teams coordinated by NCUA

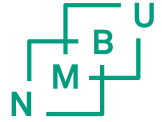


- FNR-03 **Marie Skłodowska-Curie** action (MSCA) - **DrUA** attracted 8 bids - January 15th

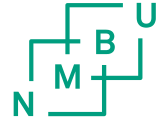

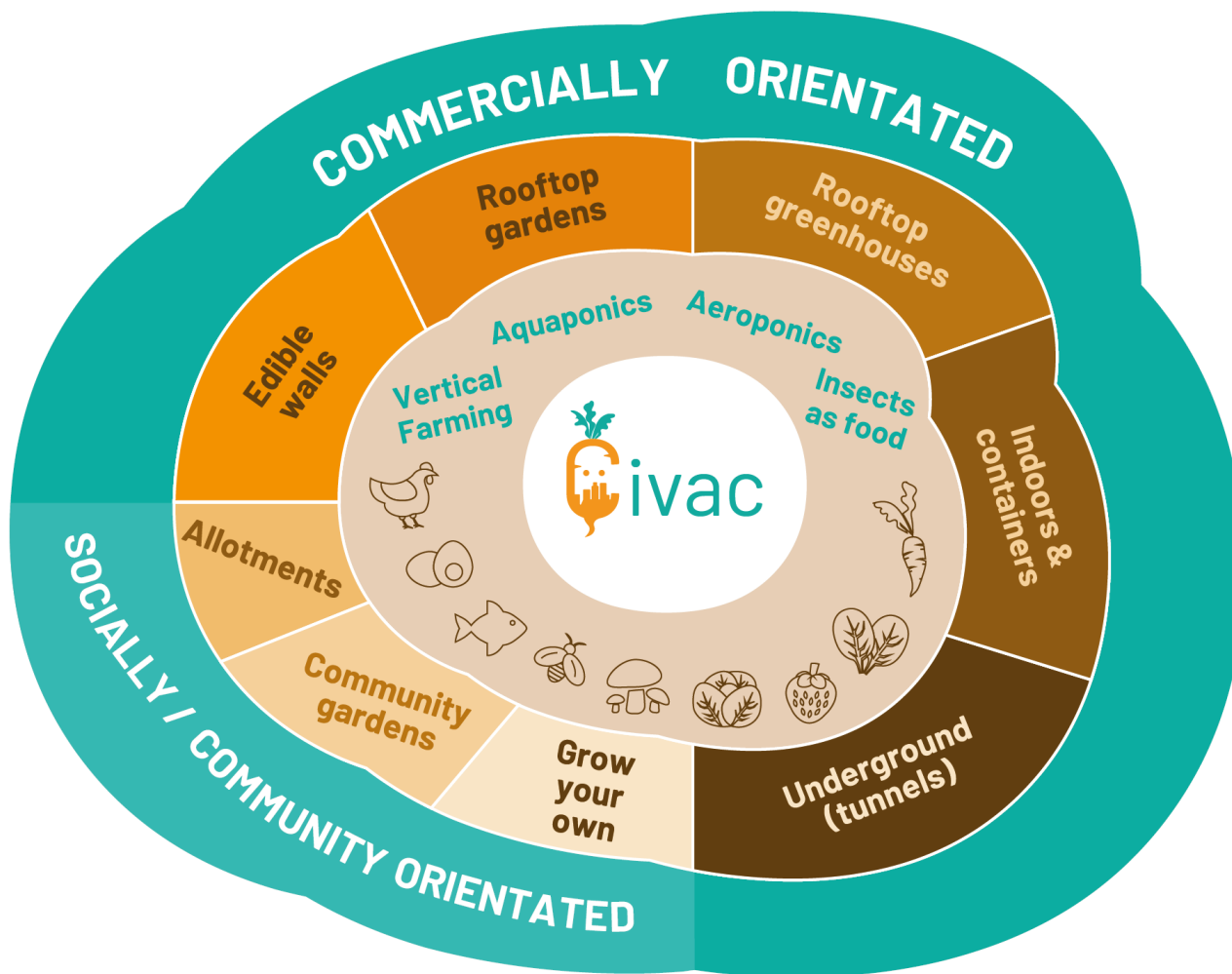

# 1.1 Objectives

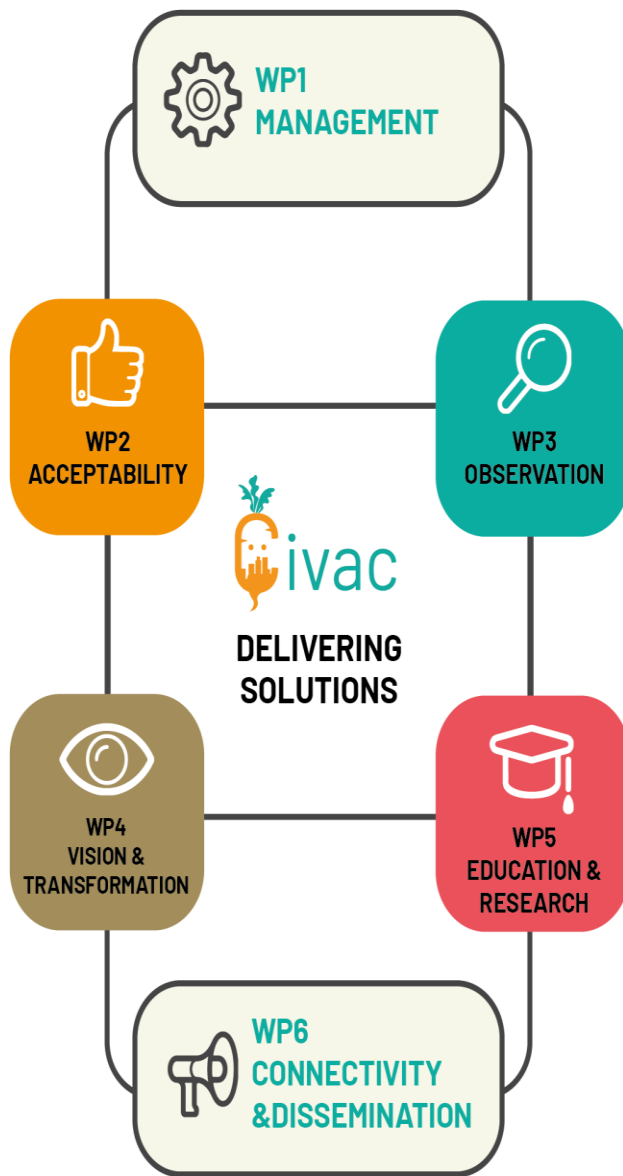
