



The Soria Moria Hotel and Conference Centre is owned by the Norwegian Medical Association. The hotel is magnificently located on Holmenkollen Mountain and surrounded by Oslo's Nordmarka Forest. Getting there:

From Oslo airport take the Airport Express to Oslo Central Station (19 min.). Or, if you like, take a taxi from Oslo Central Station directly (approx. NOK 500).
